

# HIM - HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT (HIM)

## **HIM 130 Billing and Reimbursement 3 SHC**

This course provides an introduction to medical insurance billing and reimbursement practices with emphasis on the primary payers such as Medicare and Medicaid. 2 year limit.

Prerequisites: HIM 140, HIM 141, HIM 216, and HIM 225.

Corequisites: HIM 150.

## **HIM 140 Current Procedural Terminology I 3 SHC**

This course provides a basic study of the CPT and HCPCS coding and classification systems particular to the physician's office setting.

Students will learn how to assign codes to capture the professional component of services provided. 2 year limit.

Prerequisites: AHS 102 and BIO 112.

Corequisites: HIM 216.

## **HIM 141 Current Procedural Terminology II 3 SHC**

This course provides an intermediate study of the CPT and HCPCS coding and classification systems with respect to surgical outpatient facilities and hospitals. 2 year limit.

Prerequisites: AHS 102, BIO 112, and HIM 140.

Corequisites: HIM 225.

## **HIM 150 Coding Practicum I 3 SHC**

This course provides clinical practice in the application of basic coding and classification system guidelines in selected health care facilities. 2 year limit.

Prerequisites: AHS 102, BIO 112, HIM 141 and HIM 225.

Corequisites: HIM 130.

## **HIM 216 Coding and Classification I 3 SHC**

This course includes a study of disease and procedural coding and classification systems. 2 year limit.

Prerequisites: AHS 102 and BIO 112.

## **HIM 225 Coding and Classification II 3 SHC**

This course provides a study of advanced coding and classification systems. 2 year limit.
