At all locations of Piedmont Technical College, traditional library services are blended with print and online academic resources to provide centralized support centers where students can read, study, conduct research, and complete assignments. The Marion P. Carnell Library on the Greenwood campus and the Learning Resource Centers on the county campuses provide access to academic resources such as print books, electronic books, article databases, streaming media, print periodicals, and audiovisual materials. The Library is located on the second floor of the K Building on the Greenwood campus. Off-campus access to library electronic collections and the library catalog are available 24/7.

Borrowing Library Materials

Students may borrow materials not only from the Library and the Learning Resource Centers, but also from other South Carolina academic libraries through PASCAL Delivers. A college identification card is required to check out materials.

Research & Tutor Assistance
